Music Department Tour Rules

Items to Bring:

1. When flying, you may check 2 items and take two carry ons. Small instruments will count as one carry-on. Large instruments will count as checked baggage.
2. Performance uniform, instrument, music, personal identification, ALARM CLOCK, personal toiletries, dress up clothing for special events, raincoat, umbrella, sweater or light coat, money for meals and souvenirs, traveler's checks, appropriate clothing for activities on itinerary, swimming suit, camera. **DO NOT bring things like X-Box systems, Sony Playstation, Nintendo games, etc. These items can be played at home and are too expensive to have stolen. They keep students up all night and are a distraction to the great things we tour in the first place to see. Leave them at home.**

Conduct and Behavior Rules and Regulations:

1. You are expected to be LADIES AND GENTLEMEN at all times. Bingham High is proud of the music department. Let's keep it that way. We are not only representing Bingham High School, but Jordan School District, Salt Lake City and Utah, good personal conduct is imperative. This means that you may need to give up some personal identity for group identity.
2. You must meet the bus on schedule at all times so that others will not be kept waiting. Do not leave the group at rest and lunch stops. To ensure safety reasons, always be in a group of at least 4. Invite others to be part of your group so no one is alone!!!
3. Mixed company will not be allowed in hotel rooms at any time.
4. Check carefully before you go to meet the bus. Do not leave money or valuables in rooms at any time. Rooms also must be kept orderly for the maids to clean them.
5. All rooms must be left in good order upon checkout. Pick up garbage, etc. You will be required to pay for any damage, be respectful at all times!
6. Pay for any telephone calls or room service in advance of checkout time. Be aware that there are charges for local calls.
7. You must be in your room at the scheduled bed check time. You may not leave the room after that time without making arrangements in advance with your chaperones. You may not go out for drinks or ice. Get them before bed check. Chaperones may adjust the scheduled hours to meet specific circumstances. You will be held responsible to comply with any changes announced.
8. You must be quiet in hotel rooms and hallways after 9:00 P.M. use the hotel lounge or pool area for social activities. Do not slam room doors or run in the hallways.
9. Under no circumstance should you go with anyone not of our group. You should not plan on taking long walks without approval of chaperons and without giving specific details about where you can be located. You will be allowed to leave the group to go with relatives ONLY with

prior written approval from parents or guardians. This must happen before we leave on tour. Permission will not be granted otherwise. No exceptions!!!

10. You must be properly and modestly dressed at all times. Do not wear any attire or colors which can be mistaken as gang related. Follow school dress code procedure, and then modify it even more. Do not wear shirts with sayings or logos which may be offensive to the environments we are visiting. It is important and safe to be respectful of our host areas.
11. You are not permitted to use, or be in possession of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs at any time. Prescriptions and normal medications excluded if listed on the medical release form. Lighters and other possible paraphernalia are also not permitted.
12. Immoral conduct or conduct which reflects in a negative way on the Bingham High School will be cause for disciplinary action.
13. As tour is a school activity, all policies and regulations set forth by the Jordan School District and Bingham High School apply to this trip. Please see the "B" book for additional information on school policies. The reprint at the end is a reproduction of the Jordan School District / Bingham High School statement on maintaining a safe environment for all.
14. Violation of these rules of conduct may result in your parents being notified and you being sent home immediately. You and your parents will pay for all expenses incurred for early departure from the trip.
15. Tours are for the incredible experiences we cannot duplicate in state. They are possible every year by the integrity with which we approach the opportunity. You are responsible for the reputation and continuance of this awesome tradition by living the high standards set forth by the Bingham High Music Department.
