Students interested in applying to be a Drum Major or Section Leader in the BHS Marching Band must fill out this form and will also have to schedule an in-person interview with the BHS Band Staff and Student Band Council on the allotted interview dates occurring in mid-April every year. Successful Section Leader candidates will be judged on their musical ability and knowledge on their primary instrument, leadership qualities and teaching abilities, past and present experience within the marching band program at BHS or other comparable marching program, and the overall needs of the ensemble and section. Upcoming Juniors and Seniors with said experience will be given preferential treatment, but all interested parties are encouraged to apply and will be considered.

For the Drum Major positions, the successful applicant must be an upcoming Junior, have at least on year of previous marching experience at BHS or other comparable high school marching band program (two years preferred), have very strong leadership / teaching abilities, and be willing and able to attend a summer leadership / conducting workshop at your own expense. **THIS IS A TWO YEAR COMMITMENT!**
